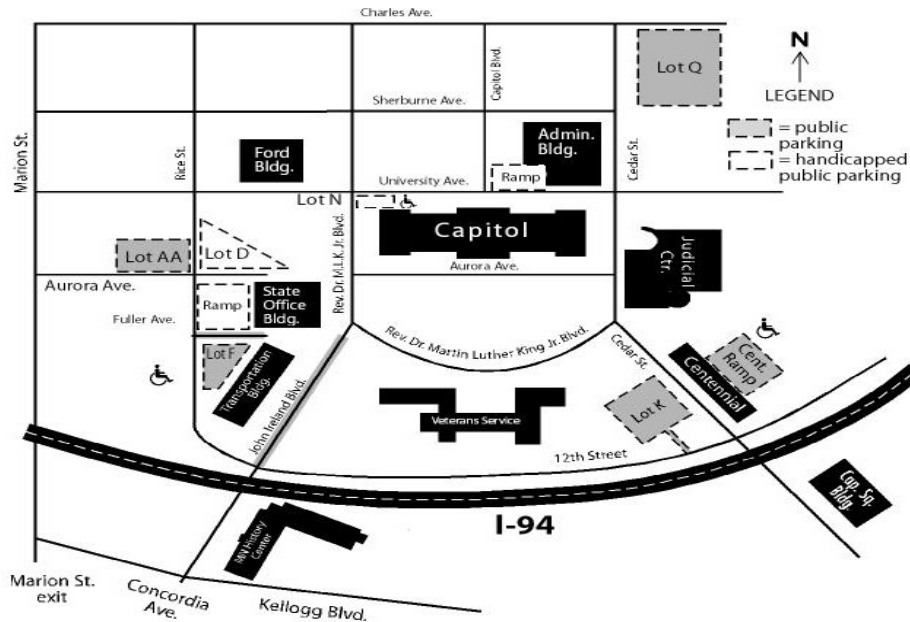


Finding Your Way Around the Capitol



Where Can I Park?

- Public metered parking is available on Aurora Ave. Parking lots with pay stations are available at Lot AA (corner of Rice St. and Aurora Ave.) and Lot F (on Rice St., at the Transportation Building). Bring quarters.
- Outdoor handicapped parking is available in Lot F and the Transportation Building. Indoor handicapped parking is available on the blue level of the Centennial Office Building Ramp; and on the entry level of the Administration Building Ramp.
- Parking is sometimes limited during the legislative session, and St. Paul Meter Patrols do issue tickets for expired meters.

Where are my legislators?

Legislators have offices in both the Capitol Building and the State Office Building (SOB).

- DFL Senators are in the State Capitol.
- Republican Senators are in the SOB.
- All Representatives are located in the SOB.

How do I get between buildings?

An underground tunnel connects the Capitol and SOB. It can take time to get through the tunnel - give yourself at least 10 minutes to get between the buildings.
